On 25 April 1850, a land grant was filed for John Person, Jr for 100 acres. It began at a tree that belonged to John Person. Sr. and was adjacent to Isaac Davis' line. It was surveyed on 15 November 1850 by Azel Sharpe, County Surveyor. Witnessed by Isaac David, Jr.

Notes for Isaiah Lowe:

Even though Isaiah Lowe was listed in the 1880 Alexander County, North Carolina Census, a notation was made that he died after 1 June 1880. His wife Nancy also states that both of Isaiah's parents were born in Kentucky. Isaiah's age in the census records is very inconsistent. In 1860 he is listed as age 59; in the 1870 census he is listed as age 72, in the 1880 he is listed as age 95. Nancy's age also varies a good deal: in the 1860 census she is listed as age 45; in the 1870 census she is age 54 and in the 1880 census she is 68. His tombstone says he was born 15 Sept 1788.

Notes for Alexander Pearson:

On 22 April 1852 Azel Sharpe, County surveyor, filed an Land grant from the state of North Carolina for 33 acres on Lower Little River for Alexander Pearson. The survey began at the corner of John Person's land and continued North until it connected to Alexander and John's corner. Then continued North along Alexander Pearson line to James Davis' land. The survey was done on 22 April 1853. Witnessed by : James H. Person and George Person.
